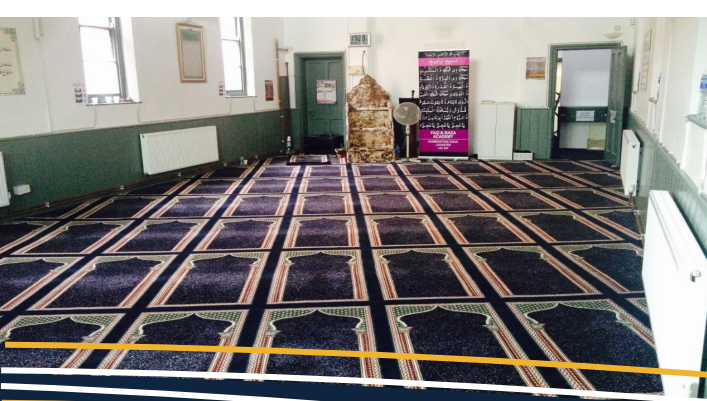

to your Mosque and Madrasah guide and an introduction to all the information you need about Faiz-e-Raza Academy.

As you may be aware, by the Grace of Almighty Allah, Faiz-e-Raza Academy was founded in Ramadan of the year 2014 with the aim of continuing the tradition of learning, practicing and teaching the core Islamic values that have been passed down through generations going back to our pious predecessors. At the same time prepare the children to be caring and respectful citizens who are able to integrate with wider communities and contribute to society whilst maintaining their core values.

A brief history

In 2009, Faiz-e-Raza Academy (previously known as “Madrasah Faiz-e-Raza”) started off in a small rented residence in the Spinney Hill area of Leicester with approximately 5 students and 1 teacher with the hope of moving to a permanent location in the future. In 2011 we ended up moving to another rented albeit larger place in the same area which was being used as a “Sound and Vision Factory”. Having assessed the situation of the local environment, we expanded our ambitions and changed the ethos of the Madrasah to make it more relevant to the youth of today whilst maintaining the fundamentals of Islamic education and spirituality.

The breakthrough came when we found a building previously used as a church in the Humberstone area in Leicester. Realising there was a need for a Masjid and Madrasah in this part of the city we decided to act swiftly and by the Grace of Almighty Allah managed to purchase our current building at a cost of £275,000.

Today, Alhamdulillah we are proud to say Faiz-e-Raza Academy has been running successfully at its current location since 2014.

RENOVATION



MAIN HALL

Previously used as the main hall for the Church as displayed in the first image, this hall was transformed from top to bottom into a large hall able to facilitate Islamic programs and assemblies. More recently, it is being used to accommodate additional classes and the school office.

Initially, the pews, organ and all the furniture were removed to begin the renovation process followed by the full rebuilding of the floor the installation of carpet tiles which were retrieved from old offices at a different location. Other additional touch-ups were made to the hall in time for the “Grand Opening” (image 4).

The second phase of renovation for the hall started a year after the opening of the school where 3 fit for purpose classrooms were built using the space on one side of the hall. (See right side page)

Renovation so far...

Main Hall -

- Removed old fixtures and furniture from the main hall as seen in the pictures.
- Rebuilt floor at a cost of **£5,000**
- Painted the walls wherever necessary.
- Fitted temporary carpet tiles retrieved from old offices.
- Built 3 fit for purpose classrooms costing **£3,500**

Mosque Hall -

- Fully re-painted the mosque hall.
- Fitted new made to measure carpet.

Classrooms -

- Fully re-painted all the classrooms.
- Fit new carpet in all classrooms
- Purchased tables and chairs to accommodate 130 children.

Central Heating System - Brand new central system for the two buildings fitted costing **£21,000**

CCTV - System fitted for the building at a cost of **£2,000**

Fire Alarm System - New Fire Alarm system fitted for the building costing **£ 5,000**
